

Living Word will be open tomorrow for its Sabbath service with some modifications due to the COVID-19 pandemic:

- 1) Bary and I are the only two required at the service. All other ministries are suspended for the foreseeable future
- 2) The people supporting the ministry team, worship team, dance team, multi-media team (sound booth), the children's church, and nurse are released from their responsibilities until further notice
- 3) Formal worship/dance practice is cancelled
- 4) Due to the government restrictions and severity of COVID-19, no one from the congregation is obligated to attend tomorrow's service. You are free to stay home or free to join Bary and me.
- 5) We will take the following precautions:
  - a. Will lock the front door as a control entry point. Knock on the door to gain entry.
  - b. Practice "social distancing" in our seating arrangements
  - c. No communion
  - d. Have soap and hot water available to wash hands
- 6) The service will consist of worship (singing songs), teaching, testimonies, and prayer

Health precautions. The disease is real and not a hoax so here's a list of people at higher risk for COVID-19 according to the CDC:

- Adults 65 years and older
- People who have serious underlying medical conditions: Heart disease, diabetes, lung disease, asthma
- Pregnant Women

We recommend anyone in these categories consider staying at home and not attending the service, especially if you're not feeling well (let us know so we can pray). You are welcome to attend but there's no problem if you choose not to attend.

For those who aren't in the high-risk category but are sick please stay home (let us know so we can pray).

For those who aren't in the high-risk category and are healthy but don't want to venture out into the public you are also encouraged to stay home.

There is no shame, no lack of faith if you stay home. You are beloved of God, a child of God, and part of the Body of Christ. We all stand together.

Discipleship Making Community: We're looking at conducting our meetings via ZOOM on Weds. Stand by for further guidance

Biblical Meal/Passover Seder: We're assessing/praying if we'll postpone the Biblical meal. It depends if the situation worsens or improves between now and Apr 12<sup>th</sup>.

Weekly Sabbath Services: We'll assess on a weekly basis. If we can't meet in the building, we'll move to house group arrangements.

Note: If you need help please let us know. We have volunteers who can shop for you, bring you medicine, pray for you, etc.... You don't have to go through this alone, we're family, we're here for each other.
