Law of the Nazirite & The Priestly Blessing Numbers Chapter 6

- Nazirite לְזָיך [naziyr, nazir /naw·zeer/]: devoted, consecrated
 - Samson (Judges 13:7), John the Baptist (Luke 1:15-17), Paul (Acts 18:18, 21:22-26)
- Bless אָרָרָ, בָרָ [barak /baw·rak/]: to kneel, to invoke divine favor
 - Jewish tradition: The LORD would shine through the fingers o the priests as they blessed the people.
 - \circ Luke 24:50 He (Yeshua/Jesus) lifted up His hands and blessed them

The Children of God 1 John 2:28 – 3:3

And now, little children, abide in Him, that when He appears, we may have confidence and not be ashamed before Him at His coming. If you know that He is righteous, you know that everyone who practices righteousness is born of Him. Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him. Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is. And everyone who has this hope in Him **purifies** himself, just as He is pure.

• Purifies - ἁγνίζω [hagnizo /hag·nid·zo/]: to dedicate oneself (Nazirite)

- 1 John 3:16-19 By this we know love, because He laid down His life for us. And we also ought to lay down our lives for the brethren. But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him? My little children, *let us not love in word or in tongue, but in deed and in truth.* And by this we know that we are of the truth, and shall assure our hearts before Him.
- 1 John 3:23-24 And this is His commandment: that we should believe on the name of His Son Jesus Christ and love one another, as He gave us commandment. Now he who keeps His commandments abides in Him, and He in him. And by this we know that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us.
